Marriage of Christian Girl

Victim of Sheikhupura Motorway Case

Bright Future Society took responsibility for the Christian Girl marriage, Victim of the Sheikhupura Motorway. BFS arranged the marriage ceremony of Christian victim girl Komal on 28th December 2020.

The incident took place on a local road about one and a half km away from the motorway, Sam Nulla, village Fatehpuri jurisdiction of Farooqabad police station, Sheikhupura district, which was clearly mentioned in the FIR.

The effected family was coming back from marriage ceremony on a rickshaw from Farooqabad to their village Kakkar Gul on the local road, suddenly few unknown terrorist appeared and intercepted them.

They snacked money and mobile phone from effected family and tied them with ropes as they took Komal D/o of Gulzar Maish who was 18 years old to nearby bushes and gang raped in front of her family.

After that the victimized girl was referred to the DHQ hospital for medical examination and an FIR registered in Saddar Farooqabad police station Sheikhupura.

The Sheikhupura RPO had taken a notice of the gang-rape case and sought a report from the district police chief, in this connection DPO said multiple teams had been formed and promised that the rapist would be arrested soon.

Mr. Samuel Payra Chairman Implementation Minority Rights Forum & President of Bright Future Society appeared in the Supreme Court and informed about that incident to the Honorable Chief Justice of Pakistan Mr. Justice Gulzar Ahmed. Mr. Justice Gulzar Ahmed took a notice

Supreme Court (SC) on had raised questions over the security condition on motorways following surge in rape cases.

According to details, Chief Justice of Pakistan (CJP) Gulzar Ahmed had condemned the mishap of raping a Christian girl in front of her family on Lahore-Sheikhupura Motorway.

The top judge had sought report from the Punjab government on the recently held two rape incidents on motorway.

Later a search operation was launched and Saddar Farooqabad police received a tip-off that suspects and their accomplices had gone towards the village Awan Bhattian.

When police reached there, suspects were robbing the commuters, on seeing police they opened fire on police that led to an exchange of fire from both sides. During this both rapists had died while their accomplices had disappeared in the darkness.

Two rapists were dead in exchange of fire and the third one who is the brother of rapists is in jail.

After all that Mr. Gulzar Maish, father of Komal a Christian victim girl contacted Mr. Samuel Payra and team to visit his house. After meeting he requested Mr. Samuel to arrange a marriage of his victimized daughter with his nephew.
